Classes are £5 per horse per class all entries to be made prior to 9.30 am on the day

Camborne heavy horse show is an all inclusive show because of its location and therefore classes will contain entries of varying types of heavy/draft horses and working Cobs with handlers of different abilities. In qualifying classes only the criteria specified by those societies will be judged although subject to entry levels the qualifier and non qualifier classes may be run together but judged separately

Exhibitors may be accompanied in the ring by an adult There are no age restrictions for this class

Class. 7. <u>YOUNG-HANDLER</u> <u>UNASSISTED</u>

The winner of Class 7 will qualify for The Shire Horse Young Handler Championship

A STRICT DRESS CODE WILL BE OBSERVED.

Persons aged 12 to 18 years — Marks 100% for Young Handler The young handler must be prepared to: -

- Lift the horse's foot and explain foot hygiene.
 - Give the age of their horse
 - Give the approx. weight of their horse
 - Give the approx. height of their horse
 - Describe the horse's diet
- Describe any work undertaken by their horse

Present their horse to the judge and complete the following moves: -

- Walk their horse
- Trot their horse
- Bring their horse to a "Stand"
- Back their horse at least four paces

At all times the Young Handler must demonstrate complete control of their horse whilst in the show ring.

Rules of the show

Refunds only available if show/class is cancelled
Bullying and Bad behaviour towards People or Animals will
not be tolerated

Any Bad behaviour towards our committee and officials will result in immediate warning and possible banning

The Judges decision is final

Any complaints must be made in writing with a £30 deposit, if the committee see the complaint unfit the deposit may not be returned.

Correct and clean turnout of both horse and handler/rider is a condition of entry, determined by the Judge and steward.

Once judging has commenced no late comers will be accepted into the ring

Failure to comply with the rules will result in loss of entry and possible removal from the showground

RULES OF QUALIFICATION - WEST of ENGLAND HEAVY HORSE CHAMPIONSHIPS

HEAVY HORSE CHAMPION IN HAND HEAVY HORSE CHAMPION IN SHOW HARNESS

- 1. Qualifiers must be from Recognised Heavy Horse Breeds, of any age, Stallions, Colts, Geldings, Fillies and Mares.
- 2. (a) The In-Hand Qualifier must be the Show Champion of the Day. If already qualified at a previous Qualifier Show then if necessary the qualifier position can go down the line to 4th
 - (b) If the top 4 horses have already qualified then NO qualifier can be nominated The Show Harness and Decorated Harness qualifier must be the highest placed on the day,down to 4th position if necessary. A set of harness can only be used upon one qualifying horse.
- 3. Should a Qualifying Horse refuse a First Qualification this will exclude that horse from qualifying in the same Championship at any further Qualifying Shows that year.
- 4. If the Qualifier subsequently be unable to attend the Championships at the Turnpike Showground (North Dorset) then the Championship Secretary must be notified. The position can then be passed to the next eligible horse
- 5. Each horse that qualifies will receive a Qualifier Rosette

Ridden Horse Judging Criteria -

Qualifier for the British Ridden Heavy Horse championships

1. Obedience and acceptance of the aids.

Horses should respond immediately and appropriately to the riders aids without showing resisitance or disobedience.

Manners

Horses should behave in an acceptable manner whilst in the ring. They should stand still when required and not show aggression to other horses in the ring

3. Way of Going.

Horses should: -

- Have correct paces & active paces
- Bend correctly thoughout movements
- Offer correct canter leads
- Remain balanced

4. Conformation and Action.

Conformation and action should be correct for the breed.

5. Presentation.

Horses should be well turned out. Tack should be well fitting and suitable for the purpose. Matingales and other artificial aids (other than whips and spurs) are not permitted in the ring though they may be used when warming up
