Classes 1 to 3 for **ANY** recognised Heavy Horse Breed.

Class 1.	In hand 3 years old and under. 1, 2 or 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding (Please ensure Colts are properly harnessed and handlers 18 years or over)
Class 2.	In hand 4 years old and over – Geldings.
Class 3.	In hand 4 years old and over – Mares.

Those placed first	st and second in classes 1.2 and 3 will be judged for BEST IN SHOW .
Best in Show	The winner will qualify for the West of England Heavy Horse In Hand Championships
Class 4.	Young Handler – ASSISTED Exhibitors must be accompanied in the ring by an adult, no colts or stallions to be shown or handled, hard hats must be worn.
Class 5.	Young Handler – 12 to 16 YEARS No colts or stallions to be shown or handled, hard hats must be worn (Every Young Handler entrant receives £5.00 prize money)

Class 9.	Heavy Horse Turnout Singles, Pairs or Teams - Agricultural wagon or implement, trade or pleasure vehicle
Class 10.	Ridden Heavy Horse – Horses 4 Years and over Walk, Trot and optional Canter. Absolutely no galloping allowed in the show ring. Flights to be removed from horses' manes please.

RULES OF THE SHOW

Bullying and Bad behaviour towards People or Animals will not be tolerated

Any Bad behaviour towards our committee and officials will result in immediate warning and possible banning

The Judge's decision is final

Any complaints must be made in writing with a £30 deposit, if the committee see the complaint unfit the deposit may not be returned.

Juniors 14 years and under must wear a hard hat at all times in the showring

Correct and clean turnout of both horse and handler/rider is a condition of entry, determined by the Judge and steward.

Once judging has commenced no late comers will be accepted into the ring

Failure to comply with the rules will result in loss of entry and possible removal from the showground

Equine Flu

All equine entries must comply with current equine flu vaccination requirements.

Please ensure that you bring your horse's passport as random checks will be carried out. Anyone who's horse is not vaccinated will be asked to leave the show ground.

There will be no refunds or travel subsistence's paid.

Public Liability Insurance

All exhibitors must have public liability insurance and a copy of the policy MUST be available for production at the show ground if requested. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have adequate liability insurance to indemnify the organisers of the event for any claims against death, injury, disease or damage to any person, vehicle or property arising from or caused by the actions of their horse or rider/driver during any activities being carried out in connection with the event.

RULES OF QUALIFICATION

- 1. Qualifiers must be from recognised Heavy Horse breeds of any age: Stallions, Colts, Mares, Fillies and Geldings.
- 2. (a)The In-Hand Qualifier must be the Show Champion of the day. If the Champion is already qualified at a previous Qualifier Show then the qualifier position can go down to 4th place, at the judge's discretion.

- (b) The Show Harness and /or Decorated Harness Qualifier must be the highest placed on the day, down to 4th position at judge's discretion.
- 3. If a Qualifier is subsequently unable to attend the Championship on 22nd September at the Turnpike Showground (between Shaftesbury and Gillingham in North Dorset) then the Championship Secretary must be notified no later than 10th September 2024. The Qualification can then be passed to the next eligible horse.

Each horse that qualifies will receive a Qualifier rosette.
